### **Sanctuary Microphones**

We have new microphones in the sanctuary, which we will be experimenting with placement over the next few weeks. They are primarily intended for the worshipers at home to be able to hear the bell choir and chancel choir on the live stream and phone stream. With an average of over 100 people weekly watching or listening online, the majority of our worship attendance continues to be by those joining us virtually.

It is an investment of over \$700, for which we are accepting donations, simply list "*microphones*" on an envelope or on the memo line of your check, or in the description for online giving. If we exceed the \$700, the remainder will go to our AV Fund for ongoing technology upgrades in the sanctuary.

Entitled *The Blue and The Gray at Gettysburg*, the trip includes Motorcoach Transportation, Admission to **Gettysburg National Military Park Visitor's Center** which includes the Museum, the Cyclorama Painting, and Film, Lunch at the **Historic Dobbin House Tavern** (includes taxes and gratuities), a **Licensed Battlefield Guide** who will board the bus and take us to many of the famous battlefield sites (includes gratuity), and an Ice Cream Treat at **Mr. G's** which is housed in the historic Twin Sycamore House.

The price is \$102 per person. The bus will depart at 8:00am from St. Daniel's Church, and return at approximately 7:00pm. The deadline for payment and registration is **Sunday, August 7, 2022**.
